Steve Williams is the Managing Director and co-founder of An Meá. He has over 15 years of international experience in Health, Safety and Environmental (HSE) management. He has worked and lived in Australia, the United States, the Philippines and Russia, providing services to companies operating in these countries as well as other countries in South East Asia (Singapore, Thailand), Europe (the United Kingdom, the Netherlands), the Middle East (Oman, Dubai), and the South Pacific (New Zealand, Kiribati).

Initially a project engineer at the Caltex refinery in Kurnell, Sydney, Steve was appointed in 1992 to an environment management role in Caltex international headquarters in Dallas. During his time in Dallas he acted as the Regional Environmental Coordinator for Australia, New Zealand and the Philippines. In 1994, Steve was appointed as the Environmental Adviser to the President, Chairman and CEO of Caltex Philippines. He returned to Australia to take up a position as the Corporate Environmental Adviser to Australia's largest downstream oil company following the merger of Caltex and Ampol in 1995.

Steve prepared environmental management systems for Caltex International and Caltex Philippines, and developed an integrated Environment, Health and Safety management system and an integrated risk management process for Caltex - Ampol in Australia.

Since forming An Meá in 1997, Steve has worked extensively in assisting clients to develop and implement HSE management systems. Key successes include:

- assisting Petroleum Development Oman to attain ISO 14001 certification in 2000. (At the time this was the largest such scope to be certified anywhere in the world), and
- developing the HSE Management System for Sakhalin Energy Investment Company. (At the time this system was developed, the Sakhalin Energy Phase II construction Project was the world's largest integrated oil and gas investment project).

Between 2004 and early 2008, Steve was based on Sakhalin Island, Russia. In this period he was the co-founder and General Director of An Mea Sakhalin LLC. He was also seconded to Sakhalin Energy Investment Company as their HSE Audit Programme Manager. In this role he developed and implemented the Company's HSE governance strategy, including its HSE Audit Program.

Steve is a highly experienced environmental auditor and is certified by RABQSA as a Lead Auditor. He was one of the first people to receive Registered Certified Environmental Auditor status in Australia. Shell International have approved Steve as a trainer for their internal HSE Auditors. His environmental audit experience includes management systems, compliance and due diligence audits of entire companies, as well as individual facilities.

Steve is an accomplished speaker and has addressed numerous conferences and seminars on a range of HSE management issues. He is also an experienced trainer and facilitator, having delivered training to Board and "shop-floor" level, and facilitated a wide range of workshops that include strategic planning, HSE action planning, and operational-level hazard identification.

Steve is a Member of the Institution of Engineers Australia. He holds a Degree in Mechanical Engineering and a Masters Degree in Business Administration.
